Title: Pursuing Impactful Careers

Speaker: Professor Jasjit Singh

Description:

In this session, we will examine how to complement your passion for serving society with strategic thinking to maximize your real impact – the difference you actually make. The essence of thinking strategically involves asking exactly what societal need you are trying to meet and for whom, and how you can position yourself to make a valuable contribution in line with your own personal goals and passions. We will argue that different kinds of organizations (e.g., social enterprises vs. for-profit companies) and funding approaches (e.g., venture philanthropy vs. impact investing) are complementary means of pursuing societal goals. We as individuals need to identify critical societal needs we care about, and contribute to these in a manner consistent with our unique strengths as well as the constraints of the context in which we choose to pursue these.

5. Embracing Feedback: Seeing feedback as a tool for improvement rather than criticism.

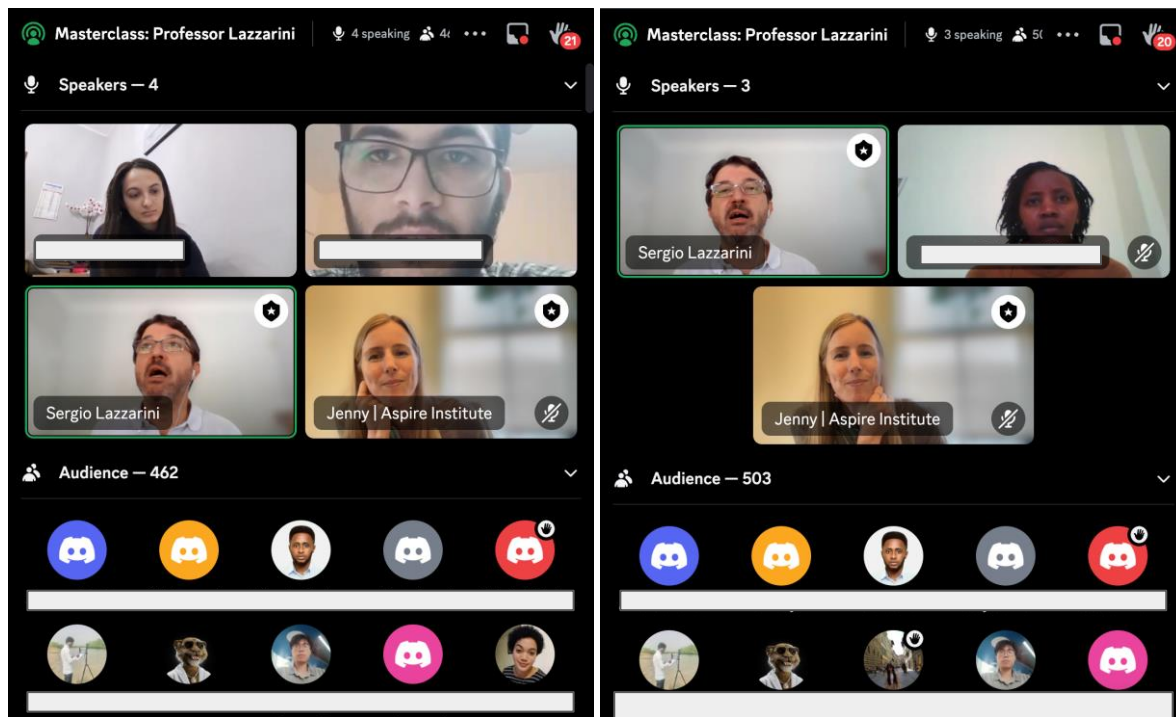

6. Continuous Learning: Stay updated on industry trends, new technologies, and best practices to adapt to changing environments.

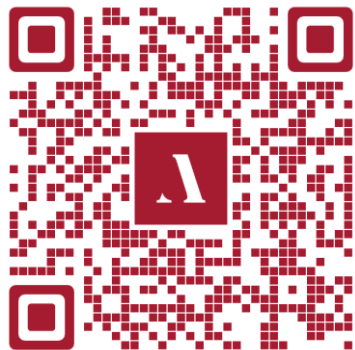
